The revised CU Furniture Modules and Finishes standards were developed with the following criteria:

Space Efficiency

By introducing slimmer dividers (Answer Boundary Screen) and a narrower desk return, the workstation footprint increased in open area feeling less constricted. Declutter. With the work becoming more digital we no longer require tons of filing space, capitalizing on leg room.

<u>Sustainability</u>

Sustainability is taking a central role. With the climate crisis and ecological impact becoming part of mainstream discourse, many offices are taking nature into account as well. Recycling, use of environment-friendly materials, reduction of plastic, and energy saving are all becoming an integral part of office design.

We are contributing to less waste with purposeful and functional components.

Modern Aesthetics

LAWS, CODES AND WARRANTIES

<u>Accessibility</u>

Columbia University (CU) is committed to fostering a fully accessible campus. The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendments Act (ADAAA), and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, are both a law and a code that prohibit discrimination against persons with disabilities. A myriad of other federal and state laws pertaining to individuals with disabilities mandate a complex set of requirements.

Universal design and ADA compliance encompass many aspects of furniture such as clearance requirements (heights, depths, and widths), ease of approachability and maneuverability within the space, and the ease of manipulation of knobs, handles, or adjustments.

Fire Life Safety

CU must also comply with current codes, rules and regulations of the City of New York regarding Fire and Life Safety. Important code provisions include, but are not limited to, maintaining an egress path and the height of furniture partitions to be 18" below the ceiling height.

In addition, CU has a policy that outlines the University's voluntary compliance with flammability standards. More detail can be found here: <u>Fire Safety Requirements for Upholstered Furniture and Furnishings | University</u> <u>Policies (columbia.edu)</u>

Note: Residential grade seating products <u>do not</u> conform to the CU policy above.

All purchased furniture and workspace layouts must meet ADA and Fire Life Safety requirements.

CU has vendor agreements with Steelcase as a preferred manufacturer through Empire and Waldners. Under this agreement, warranties are covered for contract grade furniture. Products that qualify can be found in the <u>CU Furniture Look</u> <u>Book</u>

LAWS, CODES AND WARRANTIES

Warranties

CU has a vendor agreement with Steelcase as a preferred manufacturer, offering significant discounts on a broad selection of products. Steelcase furniture is purchased through one of two dealers - Empire or Waldners. Under this agreement, warranties cover contract grade furniture. Products that qualify can be found in the <u>CU Furniture Look Book</u>.











<u>BENCHING OPEN PLAN</u> Typical Module - 2'X 4'-0" Cost: \$5,462.38






Office Seated Open Plan Office Standing w/ Dividers















