



611 West 112th Street Interior and Exterior Renovation

Columbia University is performing an interior gut renovation and exterior restoration of 611 W. 112th Street for future university housing. The project scope includes a building-wide replacement of floor and roof structure; historical restoration of the exterior masonry and recreation of the cornices; replacement of windows; new interior finishes; new mechanical, electrical, and plumbing; fire alarm, fire protection and security systems, and the creation of a new, accessible entrance.

UPDATE - Upcoming Street Closure of W. 112th Street on Saturday, September 28

What is Happening

On Saturday, September 28, W. 112th Street (between Broadway and Riverside Drive) is anticipated to be fully closed to vehicular traffic and street parking, weather permitting. This street closure is required to allow for mechanical equipment to be lifted and installed onto the roof of 611 W. 112th Street.

NOTE: Activities are subject to change based on weather and other field conditions.

What to Expect

- Vehicular traffic and street parking will not be available on W. 112th Street on Saturday, September 28 between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., weather permitting.
- A crane will be installed in front of 611 W. 112th Street beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 28.
- The sidewalk on the north side of W. 112th Street will be closed. Flaggers will be redirecting pedestrians at the crosswalks to the sidewalk on the south side of the street.
- Work hours will be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Expect noise and other impacts associated with construction.
