

Nash Main Entrance Relocation

What's Happening

Beginning on Friday, January 7, the main entrance to the Nash Building on Broadway will be temporarily closed for approximately six months. During this time, a temporary, accessible entrance will be available for building occupants on W. 133rd Street, approximately 150 feet from the Broadway entrance. This closure is required to accommodate the renovation of the building's Broadway entrance and expanded lobby, including a larger lobby reception and waiting area, new vestibule, flooring, lighting, security desk, and turnstiles.

What to Expect

- The temporary entrance at W. 133rd Street can be unlocked using your CUID card, similar to the Broadway entrance.
- The W. 133rd Street entrance leads to the second floor of the building. Signage will be available to direct occupants to the second floor Elevator A lobby, where an elevator or stairs are available to access upper and lower-level floors.
- The security desk will be relocated to the W. 133rd Street entrance and will be operated by Public Safety 24/7.
- All mail and delivery services will be rerouted to the W. 133rd Street entrance.
- Expect some noise and other impacts typically associated with construction projects
- The Broadway entrance and lobby are anticipated to reopen in July 2022.
