



Tennis Center Replacement Project

Columbia University is replacing its existing tennis facility at the Baker Athletics Complex (clubhouse and air-supported bubble) with a state-of-the-art tennis center that will enhance the experience for student-athletes and club members. The new tennis facility will have six indoor courts and six exterior rooftop courts, and will house locker rooms, offices, and associated fitness and strength rooms.

Water Main Replacement Between the Tennis Center and 218th Street

What is Happening

Beginning on or around Tuesday, May 30, work will commence to replace the water main supply line between the new tennis center facility at the Baker Athletics Complex and 218th Street. This work is anticipated to be complete in early July, weather permitting.

Project Scope

The following activities will occur:

- The first week of work will take place at 218th Street (between Indian Road and Seaman Avenue) and will include the opening of the street to install a wet tap to the water line. This work will take approximately one week.
- Beginning the week of June 5, the replacement of the water main replacement will commence at the tennis center building at Baker Athletics Complex, with work moving toward 218th Street as the project progresses. This work will take approximately 6 to 7 weeks.

-Please note that all activities are subject to change based on weather and other field conditions-

What to Expect

- Work hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- There will be asphalt saw cutting, jackhammering, delivery of materials, and other construction activities in support of the work. Expect intermittent construction noise, truck deliveries, debris removal, and other impacts typical of construction projects. After every work shift, trench openings will be plated to facilitate public use.
- There will be impacts to street parking in the area of Seaman Avenue and the end of 218th Street. Lane closures are not expected. Please follow the direction and guidance of the construction flag persons who will be directing pedestrian traffic, as needed, on the street.
- The entrance to the Muscota Marsh park will not be impacted. However, use caution and follow signage for sidewalk adjustments.
