What is Happening

Monumental Window Restoration

- Removal of window parts is ongoing. The contractor will bring window parts to the ground level via exterior scaffolding/hoist.

Air Handler Unit Replacement

- New temperature sensors and thermostats have been installed
- Controls and programming are in progress
- The new air handler unit will be placed in manual operation on an as-needed basis until the installation of automatic controls and programming is completed
- Work is anticipated to continue through early March to finalize controls and complete project closeout

Equipment Removal and Repair/Replacement of Portions of the Roof

- Installation of the new roof system is complete
- Relocation of mechanical equipment is underway
- Removal of additional dunnage from the roof is ongoing

What to Expect

- Expect some noise from demolition and other impacts typically associated with construction projects
- Overhead heating will not be available for rooms 106, 107, and 108; steam radiators will be functional to provide heat. The new heating system will be placed in manual operation on an as-needed basis until automatic controls and programming are completed. Please contact your supervisor regarding any space temperature concerns.
- Access to the West Gallery from the 4th floor will be blocked for the duration of the project

Schedule

Monumental Window Restoration

The monumental window restoration will be performed in three phases to remove the window, restore it offsite, and reinstall the restored window frame and parts. Work hours for the removal phase will be 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The final project completion is anticipated by the end of fall 2022, weather permitting.

Air Handler Unit Replacement

Regular work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, with weekend work as needed. This project is anticipated to be completed by March 2022.

Equipment Removal and Repair/Replacement of Portions of the Roof



Regular work hours will be 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with work taking place on Saturdays as needed. The roof equipment removal is anticipated to be complete during the first quarter of 2022.
