Interior Space and Critical Building System Upgrades

Construction Activities for the Next Two Weeks

Columbia University is performing renovations of various interior spaces and critical building systems at the Nash Building. The first phase, focusing on core infrastructure of the building, will include expansion of the elevator lobby, installation of two new building elevators, emergency life safety system, utilities relocation, collateral moves associated with the elevator build-out, and partial fit-out renovations of the second through fifth floors. The first phase of the project is anticipated to be complete during the third quarter of 2022.

Construction Activities for the Weeks of December 27, 2021 and January 3, 2022

Although contractors carefully stage construction activities to minimize disruption, the nature of construction work is such that some disruptions will occur. The community should expect the following in the coming weeks:

What is Happening

- Installation of a new fire alarm system in the basement, 2nd and 8th floors. Fire alarm work on the 2nd floor and basement will occur during regular hours. All other work will occur off-hours.
- Concrete and masonry work in the basement will occur for the new elevator pit. The elevator pit concrete pour will be performed on Wednesday, December 22. The masonry walls for the elevator pit will continue the weeks of December 27 and January 3.
- Carpentry work at the 3rd floor office suite will continue
- Installation of roofing and waterproofing on the roof
- Installation of conduit runs on the roof
- Plumbing Installation in basement parking garage

What to Expect

Building occupants should expect the following in the next coming weeks:

- Regular work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, with after-hours work performed between 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- Delivery of concrete is scheduled for Wednesday, December 22. The delivery will occur over a 6-hour window and will take place on Old Broadway at the freight elevator.
- On Friday, January 7, the main entrance to the Nash Building on Broadway will be temporarily closed for approximately six months. During this time, a temporary, accessible entrance will be available for building occupants on W. 133rd Street, approximately 150 feet from the Broadway entrance.
- Security will be posted at the entrance on Old Broadway during normal construction hours and off-hour shifts
- The 5th floor women's restroom is out of service. Please use restrooms on adjacent level floors.
- Freight elevator construction deliveries will be from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. typically, but also will occur between 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for after-hours work. Large delivery trucks will be standing on Old Broadway to deliver construction materials and will not be idling for longer than 2 minutes.
