



# C.V. Starr East Asian Library Reading Room Renovation

Columbia University Facilities and Operations is performing a renovation of the C.V. Starr East Asian Library on the 300 level of Kent Hall to restore the historic decorative plaster ceiling. The project will also include other improvements such as new group study rooms, new accessible lobby entrance doors, a new circulation desk, new and refurbished dimmable lighting, carpet replacement in the reading room, new furniture, and a restoration of the historic stained-glass window. This will be the first renovation of the C.V. Starr East Asian Library since 2009.

## Construction Activities for the Weeks of June 1, 2026 and June 8, 2026

Although contractors carefully stage construction activities to minimize disruption, the nature of construction work is such that some disruptions will occur. The community should expect the following in the coming weeks:

### What is Happening

- Removal of existing flooring on the 300 level
- Fire sprinkler work on the 300 level, which will include intermittent drilling noise from the attachment of sprinkler pipes
- Masonry repairs at the 300-level ceiling vault
- Demolition of millwork and finishes in perimeter rooms of the library
- Electrical work including identification of circuits and removal of raceways
- Site maintenance including upkeep of site protection and regular cleaning
- Verification of field conditions

### What to Expect

- Regular work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with after-hours work performed as needed.
- The project's construction work will create disruptions typically associated with construction projects, including some intermittent noise (e.g. drilling, cutting, and moving of equipment) and vibrations. Dust will be confined to the project space.
- Floor protection will be installed in common spaces along the path of travel for deliveries and personnel. Public spaces will be cleaned daily.
- A construction barrier at the Starr Library entrance will be in place in the building lobby of Kent Hall for the duration of the project.
